Career Plan Project

Objective: Students will create a comprehensive set of steps to take in order to reach their individual career goal.

- 1. From your career research on the O*NET site, http://www.mynextmove.org/explore/ip determine which career you would like to make as your career goal. If after researching on the O*NET site and/or Bureau of Labor site, you want to change your career goal make your change.
- 2. Research exactly what steps you need to complete in order to achieve your career goal. Be sure to detail each step you should take to meet your goal.
- 3. From your research, create a career plan detailing what steps you must take and when to reach your goal.

Include a clear, year by year, time-line showing what you will do, what experience(s) you will need, and education you will acquire each year.

Be sure to include education. What level of education do you need and where will you get it? What are the requirements to get such education? What job related experience will you get from part-time jobs or volunteer positions? When will you begin to get your experience?

Start with this year- 2016/2017 9^{th} / 10^{th} grade what classes do you have to take to graduate from H.S.? 11^{th} ?

College- where will you go? Classes to take? What degree will you need? Do you need to earn additional certificates or degrees? How many years will it take to earn your degree?

- *Remember, you may not reach your goal right after college, or as soon as you enter the workforce, so show what positions you will have before you reach your desired career.
- **Don't forget part time jobs or volunteer positions you might have during high school and/or college??

- -Your career plan must include a clear time-line showing <u>year by year</u> what you will do to reach your goal
- -Your career plan must include a detailed, written description of why you want to strive for your career goal (be specific) If you have a back up plan this is where you would explain it as well. (essay format 3 paragraphs)
