- 3. From your research, create a career plan detailing what steps you must take and when to reach your goal.

Include a clear, year by year, time-line showing what you will do, what experience(s) you will need, and education you will acquire. Be sure to include education. What level of education do you need and where will you get it? What are the requirements to get such education? What job related experience will you get from part-time jobs or volunteer positions? When will you begin to get your experience?
