Student Loan Interview

For your interview with a person who took on student loans please ask the following questions:

- 1. When you accepted student loans to pay for tuition and/or books and living expenses, did you feel like it was your only option to pay for college?
- 2. Did you make a budget for yourself before you accepted student loans?
- 3. Do you feel it was difficult or easy to get student loans to pay for college?
- 4. Were you surprised with any aspects relating to student loans?
- 5. Did you have the option to take more money in loans than you actually needed? If so did you take the money and what did you do with it?
- 6. Looking back, do you feel like there were other options to pay for college that you could have utilized instead of student loans?
- 7. What was your college major?
- 8. Is your professional career tied to the major you chose in college?

*Alternative to those not going directly to college: Ask someone who has used a credit card to purchase a large priced item

- 1. Have you used a credit card to pay for a large priced item? If so, what was the item?
- 2. Do you budget your money each month?
- 3. When you have credit card debt, do you find it tempting to pay only the minimum payment rather than paying more than required?
- 4. Think back to the first time you used a credit card, were you surprised with any aspects relating to the fees and/or interest?
- 5. Have you ever used the cash advance option of a credit card? If so, were the fees more than purchases made directly from the credit card?
- 6. Did your high school or college offer a personal finance class? If so, did you take it? What do you remember most about the class?
- 7. Looking back, do you feel like there were other options rather than a credit card to pay for your large item/s?
