"Where Your Natural Abilities Meets Your Personal Passion"

Standard: Entrepreneurship III. Assess personal skills, abilities, aptitudes, and personal strengths and weaknesses as they relate to having an entrepreneurship mentality.

Essential Question: Why is it essential for you to explore what passions/talents you have that you can gain you personal achievement?

Together with your group, you will have to put together a 20 minute presentation over your assigned chapter from *The Element*. The purpose of this assignment is to not only inform your fellow classmates on the information provided in your assigned chapter, but to also show that you understand your audience (teenagers) and can use tones, formats, styles and activities that accurately meet the needs of your audience.

Your 20 minute presentation will include the following:

- A Keynote/Google Presentation covering the information in the chapter Font 24 pt. or larger. Color and graphics/images on every slide
- An **in-class activity** (nothing that requires homework) that explores the main idea of your chapter
 - o Discussion Questions
 - o Game ex. Jeopardy
 - o Video
 - O Any other activity that you think covers the main idea
- A poster on poster board that gives a visual representation of your chapter

The entire project is worth 30 points and will be an individual grade.

Absent on the day you present? *Not a good idea.*

If you are absent on the day of your group's presentation, your group still has to present, even if only one member of the group is present. This means that if the person in your group who made the Keynote is absent, YOU STILL HAVE TO PRESENT. It's a good idea to use Google Presentations so this doesn't happen

Also, if you are absent on the day your group presents, you will not receive the same grade. Instead, you will receive 15% lower grade than your group.
